

- 1 Bacchus (★★, \$\$)**
[4 S. Chestnut (Rt208s), 255-8636] The classic New Paltz climber's watering hole. 100's of bottled beers. Burgers, wings, and now with a big billiard hall. Larger menu and salad bar found upstairs.
- 2 Bakery (★★★, \$)**
 [13a N. Front Street, 255-8840] Good hangout/meeting place in the am. Bigger selection than Starbucks. Bagels, some sandwiches, soups. Nice outdoor (shaded) patio.
- 3 Barnaby's (★, \$\$)**
[16 N. Chestnut Street (Rt32n, 255-2433] Beautifully renovated, food is on par with other taverns. Tends to cater to an older crowd.
- 4 Beso (★★★★, \$\$\$\$)**
[46 Main Street, 255-1426] Upscale American bistro. Excellent food, small portions with many local sources. Service is professional but on the slow side. Sometimes too noisy for 2, good for a group.
- 5 Biggy's BBQ Bistro (NR, \$\$)**
[36 Main Street, 255-4500] New BBQ, Aug 2006.
- 6 Cookies & Cream (★★★, \$)**
[11 Main Street, 255-8780] Ice Cream/Juice Bar/ Snacks. Hardworking owner make ice cream on site. Juices not organic, good yogurt shakes, muffins, energy bars and drinks. Good for quick pick me up.
- 7 Gadaletto's (★★★, \$\$\$)**
[246 Main Street (Cherry Hill Plaza), 255-1717] Very fresh very good seafood in a drab, drafty restaurant. Good service, live music some nights. Never go wrong with fish & chips with sweet potato fries.
- 8 Gilded Otter Brewing Co. (★★, \$)**
[3 Main Street, 255-1717] Bacchus rival brews their own beers in big beautiful, noisy restaurant/brewery. The food trails the beer in quality. Lively atmosphere; great views from the outdoor patio.
- 9 Harvest Cafe (★★★, \$\$\$)**
[10 Main Street (Water St. Market, Upstairs), 255-4205] Small, restaurant with spectacular views from its outdoor deck. Nicest outdoor dining in town. Gourmet menu with lots of locally sourced food.
- 10 Hokkaido (★★★, \$\$\$)**
[18 Church Street (Water St. Market, Upstairs), 256-0621] Best Japanese in town. Good sushi, cooked dishes vary. Recommend: Hamachikama, Green Dragon Roll. Nice outdoor patio.

- 11 Jack's Meats (★★★, \$)**
[79 Main Street, 255-2244] Best deli in town. Good sandwiches w/ organic meats (or not). Egg sandwich breakfast. Fun, young, good natured crew.
- 12 La Stazione (★★, \$\$\$)**
[5 Main Street, 256-9447] Upscale Northern Italian located in renovated N.Paltz Train Station. Unremarkable. Standard fare.
- 13 Lemongrass (★, \$)**
[Main Street, 256-0161] Thai food. Unremarkable.
- 14 Locust Tree (★★★★, \$\$\$\$)**
[215 Huguenot Street, 255-7888] Upscale country dining. Very good gourmet fare in elegant farmhouse setting. Relaxed, quiet, charming. Locally sourced.
- 15 Main Course (★★★, \$\$\$)**
[232 Main Street (Eckert Plaza), 255-2600] American bistro-style food. A notch below Beso in price/food/service. Food can be uneven, but a few gems on the menu keep fans coming back.
- 16 Main Street Bistro (★★, \$)**
[59 Main Street, 255-7766] Hip, funky diner with many choices, but everything comes off a Sysco truck; tastes it. Service is brisk and the atmosphere lively. Crowds are more tradition than testament. Tofu Stir fry: Good, *Instant* oatmeal: yuck!
- 17 Mexicali Blue (★★★, \$)**
[87 Main Street, 255-5551] Burrito/Tacateria a la Baha Fresh. Great burrito's grilled fresh in tiny shop. Tuna burrito w/wasabi highly recommended.
- 18 Moon Light Cafe (★★, \$)**
[53 Main Street, 255-4813] Middle Eastern fare with decent food and an all you can eat buffet on Friday's starting at 4pm.
- 19 Mudd Puddle Coffee Roasters (★★★, \$)**
 [10 Main Street (Water St. Market), 255-3436] Relaxed and very good small coffee shop plus run by husband/wife team. Off the beaten path but worth it for coffee, panini sandwiches, and soups.
- 20 Neko Sushi (★★, \$\$\$)**
[49 Main Street, 255-0162] Japanese at good location. The service is notably good, but the sushi isn't as good as Hokkaido.
- 21 New Paltz Indian (★★★, \$)**
[1 N. Manheim Street (by M&T Bank), 255-6441] Traditional Indian. The big and varied Tuesday night all-you-can-eat buffet is the best deal around and brings a deserved crowd. Otherwise good food & service but a little pricey. Park at M&T, not garage.

- 22 P & G's (★, \$\$)**
[91 Main Street, 255-6161] Tavern catering to consistent audience of bikers on weekends, college students at night. Food leans to the greasy, sauce-covered side.
- 23 Plaza Diner (★★, \$)**
[Stop & Shop Plaza, 255-1030] A good no nonsense diner with a vast menu, fast pleasant service and run by the on-site owner.
- 24 Rino's Pizza (★★, \$)**
[Cherry Hill Plaza, across from Stop&Shop, 255-8600] In a sea of pizza joints this one stands out. Grandma-style recommended.
- 25 60 Main (★★, \$)**
 [60 Main Street] Coffee/Juice Bar/Cultural Collective. Attracts a young left wing crowd. Sidewalk music, poetry, books on social issues. Very alternative.
- 26 Suruchi (★★★, \$)**
[5 Church Street, 255-2772] Vegetarian Indian. *Built* and run by a husband/wife team, this earnest indian serves good, well spiced indian dishes made from scratch. The service can be slow when busy, but they're new at this biz.
- 27 Tokyo Sushi (★★, \$)**
[117 Main Street, 255-1335] Sushi & Korean. OK sushi and good korean dishes w/ big servings.
- 28 Village Tea Room (★★★, \$)**
[Plattekill Ave (across from Starbucks), 255-3434] This often overlooked side street restaurant has a small menu of very good, stick to your ribs home cooked dishes and fresh soup daily. Great baked goods made from scratch. VGood bfast, too.
- 29 Yanni (★★★, \$)**
[51 Main Street, 246-0988] Greek specialties in lively environment. Good gyros,souvlaki, veggie platter. Good baklava for dessert. Excellent spot for catching up on World Cup matches. Open late.
